Annenberg School of Nursing (ASN) offers a 22 day program that includes theory and clinical education. The State C.N.A. exam is proctored at our location the Saturday following the class graduation.

The CNA class:

- meets Monday thru Friday
- hours are from 6:45 AM until 3:30 PM
- tuition costs \$1,400.00 and must be paid in full prior to graduation

Tuition includes cost for:

- Medical physical, drug screen, and TB test,
- Live Scan fingerprinting and background check,
- Book and workbook,

- CPR Training and card,
- 3 ASN T-shirts,
- Graduation pin
- State C.N.A. Exam fee

Entrance requirements included:

- must be age 18 or older
- have a High School Diploma/ GED (from the United States)*
- successfully pass the Evaluation Exam (40 questions on basic English & Math) \$10 fee payable by check, money order or cashier's check only. Evaluation Exam is by appointment only.

Enrollment requirements are:

- Provide a valid California ID/Driver's License,
- Social Security Card
- Complete and pass a medical physical, drug screen, and TB test
- Complete and pass background review that includes Live Scan fingerprinting
- Interview with ASN Director
- Minimum deposit of \$400.00 towards tuition
- Students must be dressed in school uniform at all times**
