



## **Annenberg School of Nursing Vocational Nursing Program**

Annenberg School of Nursing (ASN) offers a 13-month comprehensive study in the science of nursing that is divided into 4 (12-week) terms.

### **The Vocational Nursing Class:**

- Meets Monday thru Friday at 19300 Sherman Way, Reseda, CA 91335 or clinical locations
- Hours are from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm for Theory classes for a total of 639 hours
- Hours are from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm for Clinical placements for a total of 1041 hours
- Total cost \$25,100.00 and must be paid in full prior to graduation
- Financial Aid is available for qualified individuals
- Students eligible for ASN scholarships
- Students must be in school uniform at all times

### **Cost includes:**

- Medical physical, drug screen, TB test and Hepatitis B Series vaccination
- LiveScan fingerprinting and Background check
- All books, workbooks and ATI online resources
- Uniforms and clinical supplies
- CPR, FIRE and MAB training
- Tuition
- NCLEX-PN® Examination fee
- BVNPT License fee

### **Entrance requirements include:**

- Must be 18 or older
- Have a High School Diploma or GED (from the United States) / or Evaluated Transcripts from High School (if educated out of the U.S.)
- Completed the ATI TEAS exam with an overall "proficient" level
- Speak, read and comprehend the English language
- Be physically able to perform duties required of a nurse

### ***Enrollment requirements included, but not exclusive, are:***

- *Provide a valid CA Identification/Driver's License*
- *Provide physical Social Security Card*
- *Provide verification of COVID vaccination (required by clinical sites)*
- *Provide physical High School Diploma or GED Certificate*
- *Complete and pass medical physical, drug screen, and TB test*
- *Complete and pass Background Review*
- *Interview with ASN Director*

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The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is a pre-entry exam used to evaluate the academic preparedness of students entering the vocational nursing program. Minimum score required is “proficient”. TEAS exam results are valid for one (1) year. Previously taken TEAS exams, within one year, may be accepted if the admission results (official transcript) from ATI are sent directly to ASN. If exam is not passed on the first attempt, one retake is allowed.

**The following is a statement from The Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education, “Regulations 948329(j): No institution offering programs or courses of instruction represented to lead to occupations of job titles requiring licensure or certification shall enter into a course of instruction with a person the institution knows or by exercised of reasonable care, should know, would be ineligible to obtain licensure to the occupation or job title to which the course of instruction is represent to lead, at the time of scheduled date of course completion for reasons such as age, physical characteristics, or relevant past criminal history.”**
